
At the Sign In screen, type in cps






Click on Animals.




Click on Birds.




Click on a bird you are interested in learning more about from the list.

Click on the name of the bird (blue text) found under **Book Articles** (will be first). Note: There will be several results. **You can click on more than one to read!**




Read - As you begin reading, take a look at the HEADINGS and MAIN IDEAS.
